In my 16 Jun letter I asked these questions:

- 1) Does Todd Schwartz, a state attorney, lose his attorney license as he lied to the public? See email sequence for details.
- 2) Is Todd Schwartz required to take a report of a crime to the Court, so a Judge / Jury decide if it is a crime?
- 3) Can another state attorney be assigned to this case who will take this report of a crime to the Court, so a Judge / Jury decide if it is a crime?

While these are still valid questions, I wonder if Todd Schwartz should be removed as a state attorney.

It appears that Todd Schwartz **did not** visit the Esther Eisenbeis farmland. This is based on his 28 Jun 2023 email, "the mine had operation on that land".

If he had visited the farmland, it would have been obvious that the land is still being farmed. The evidence is clear that there has been no mining operation on the farmland.

It appears to be negligent for a state attorney to make decisions without viewing the evidence.
